## 1. The Promoter

The promoter is: The Guide Association ("Girlguiding") of 17-19 Buckingham Palace Road, London, SW1W 0PT.

## 2. The competition

2.1 The title of the competition is Create a Recycling Superhero

2.2 To enter, a parent or guardian must take a photograph of their Rainbow daughter's recycling superhero and email it to [partnerships@girlguiding.org.uk](mailto:partnerships@girlguiding.org.uk). In the email, they need to include their daughter's name, age and Rainbow unit. As well as a description of what's their superpower, how they turn into the superhero, how the superhero knows they need to help people recycle and what they say when they're about to use their superpower. The winner and 9 runners up will be chosen by Girlguiding and Daisy Corporate Services. Only one entry will be accepted per person.

2.3 To enter this competition, the entrant must be a Rainbow Girlguiding member (an "Entrant").

## 3. How to enter

3.1 The competition will run from 8.00pm on 11 October 2023 (the "Opening Date") to 00:00am on 14 November 2023 (the "Closing Date") inclusive.

3.2 All competition entries must be received by Girlguiding by no later than midnight on the Closing Date. All competition entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.

3.3 To enter the competition:

- (a) – Entrants can either draw your recycling superhero, make it out of recycled materials or dress a doll or teddy.
  - Think about what they'll be wearing.
  - What's their superpower? How do they help people to recycle and save the planet?
  - How do they turn into this superhero?
  - What job would they do during the day when they're not saving the planet?
  - How does the superhero know they need to help people recycle and save the planet?
  - What do they say when they're about to use their super power?

Once Entrants have designed their recycling superhero, you as their parent or guardian are responsible for submitting it. You need to please take a photograph and email it to [partnerships@girlguiding.org.uk](mailto:partnerships@girlguiding.org.uk). Please include the Entrants' name, age including their Rainbow unit in the email. Please share all details (provided by the Entrant) about their superhero, including all the things above.

- (b) Only one entry will be accepted per Entrant.
- (c) You agree to share contact information including delivery address with Guide Association Trading Service Limited to receive the prize.

3.4 Girlguiding will **not** accept:

- (a) responsibility for competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.

3.5 By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

3.8 The winner will be chosen by Girlguiding and Daisy Corporate Services after the competition closes.

#### **4. Eligibility**

4.1 The competition is only open to Rainbow Girlguiding members in the UK, except:

- (a) Entrants who are related to (for example, children of) employees of Girlguiding or its subsidiary companies;
- (b) employees of agents or suppliers of Girlguiding or its subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with the competition or its administration;

4.2 Entrants' parental or guardian consent to enter and claim any prize, will be required. Girlguiding may ask the parent/guardian of the Girlguiding Rainbow winner to provide proof of age/membership.

4.3 In entering the competition, you confirm that the Entrant is eligible to do so (in accordance with these terms) and eligible to claim the prize **OR** any prize they may win. Girlguiding may require you to provide proof that the Entrant is eligible to enter the competition.

4.4 Girlguiding will not accept competition entries that are:

- (a) automatically generated by computer;
- (b) completed by third parties or in bulk;
- (c) illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with; or
- (d) photocopies and not originals.

4.5 Girlguiding reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.

4.6 Competition entries cannot be returned.

## **5. The prize**

5.1 There are 10 prizes available.

5.2 The winning recycling superhero will be turned into a cartoon character. 9 runners up will receive goody bags from Daisy.

5.3 Prizes are subject to availability. There is no cash alternative for the prize.

5.4 The prize is supplied by Guide Association Trading Service Limited ("Trading") of 17-19 Buckingham Palace Road, London, SW1W 0PT (the "Supplier"). Girlguiding reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond Girlguiding's control makes it necessary to do so.

5.5 The prize is not negotiable or transferable.

## **6. Winners**

6.1 The decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

6.2 Girlguiding will contact the winner's parent/guardian personally as soon as practicable after the Announcement Date, using the email account provided with the competition entry. Girlguiding will not amend any contact information once the competition entry has been submitted.

6.3 Girlguiding must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation Girlguiding will publicly comment on the winning entries.

6.4 If you object to any or all of the Entrant's surname or county being published or made available, please contact Girlguiding. In such circumstances, Girlguiding must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

## **7. Claiming the prize**

- 7.1 Please allow 14 days for delivery of the prize.
- 7.2 The prize may not be claimed by a third party on your behalf.
- 7.3 Girlguiding shall make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed their prize within 7 days of the Announcement Date, Girlguiding reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date.
- 7.4 Girlguiding does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.

## **8. Limitation of liability**

Insofar as is permitted by law, Girlguiding, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of Girlguiding, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

## **9. Ownership of competition entries and intellectual property rights**

- 9.1 Girlguiding does not claim any rights of ownership in your competition entry.
- 9.2 You agree that Girlguiding may, but is not required to, make your entry/ the Entrant's entry available on its website [[www.girlguiding.org.uk](http://www.girlguiding.org.uk)] and any other media, whether now known or invented in the future, and in connection with any publicity of the competition. You agree on behalf of the Entrant to grant Girlguiding a non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable licence, for the full period of any intellectual property rights in the competition entry and any accompanying materials, to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, edit, alter, store, re-format and sub-licence the competition entry and any accompanying materials for such purposes.

## **10. Data protection and publicity**

**11. General**

- 11.1 If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, Girlguiding may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.
- 11.2 Girlguiding reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel or amend the prize or competition where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 11.3 If any term is found to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable it shall be severed and deleted from these terms and conditions, and the remaining terms shall survive and remain in full force and effect.
- 11.4 These terms and conditions shall be governed by English Law, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
