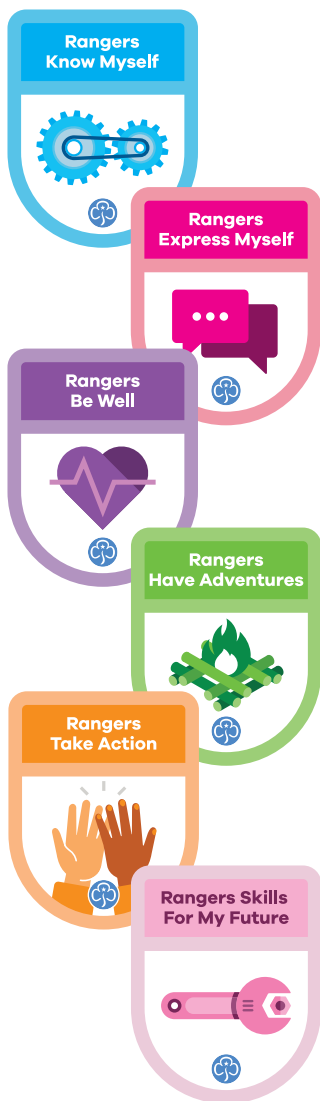

RANGER AWARDS AND BADGES



Theme awards recognise your effort and commitment at trying new things and learning new skills. There is a Theme award badge for all six themes. If you earn all six Theme awards, you can decide to work towards the Ranger Gold award.

How to earn your Theme awards

It's the same combination for each Theme award you decide to work towards and you can complete them in any order. You pick and choose which badges and activities to complete.
