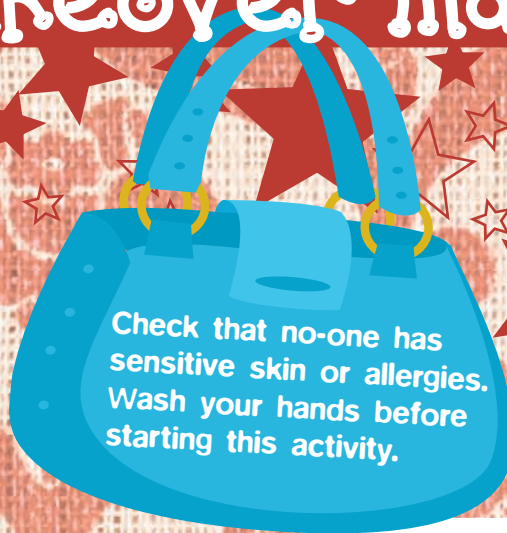


Makeover madness



Check that no-one has sensitive skin or allergies. Wash your hands before starting this activity.

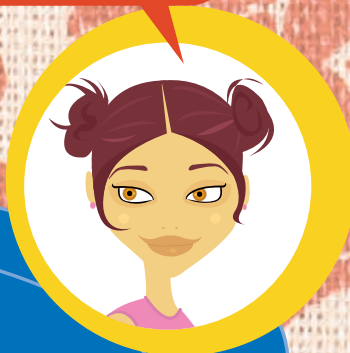
Imagine that you are going to a glam party, such as the Oscars or a ball. Think about how you might look, then get started! Help and advise each other, so the whole Patrol ends up looking a million dollars!

You will need

- * Cotton wool
- * Tissues
- * Cotton wool buds
- * Cleanser
- * Moisturiser
- * Hairbands, clips and bobbles
- * Glitter sprays
- * Each person should bring in her own make-up, brushes and combs

- Think about the colours you might choose for your foundation. Do the colours complement your skin tone? Test along your jaw line – if the foundation blends in easily then it is a good match.
- Use loose powder to fix your foundation. Apply it with a large make-up brush. Press the brush onto your face and then gently brush across to remove the excess.

Why not get a disposable camera and take 'before and after' pictures to see the difference?



- Use three colours for your eyes. A neutral base covers the whole eye area. Use the lighter of the two remaining shades over the ball area, and the darker shade on the outer corner of the eyeball. Blend them together.
- Apply your blusher to each cheek in an upward and outward sweep. The colour should bring your skin to life, but remember not to overdo it.
- Lip colour should complement the eye colour and cheek colour, ie pink lips, pink cheeks or peachy cheeks, peachy lips.
- For that final touch, add a little mascara.

Once your make-up is done, try out some elegant hairdos to go with it!
