

What's on the cards?

Try your luck with the 3R game!

1

Cut the card into equal-sized squares (you'll need at least 20).

2

Number ten of the cards: 1 to 5 in one colour and 6 to 10 in another.

3

Mix all the cards up (the ten numbered ones and the blank ones) and lay them numbered sides down in a line. Write 'home' on the last card.

4

Put all the playing pieces at the start. Take it in turns to throw the dice, and move that number of squares. When you land on a square, turn it over. If it has a number on, follow that number's instruction on the list opposite. Winner is the first 'home'!

You will need

- Scrap card
- Scissors
- Pens (2 colours)
- Dice
- Counters or playing pieces

1. You left the tap dripping: go back 2
2. Left the TV on standby: go back 1
3. A window's open and the heating is on: miss a go
4. Left your phone charger on all night: go back 2
5. You haven't been recycling: go back to the start
6. TV turned off at the mains: go forward 1
7. You always turn the lights off: go forward 1
8. You bought recycled paper: go forward 2
9. Trip to the recycling centre: have another go
10. Walk to school instead of getting a lift: step forward 3

Game on

Try a different game: create a playing-board and make up some forfeit cards with actions, eg 'You have ten seconds to find something in the room made of plastic or lose a turn'.
