Magic and Mayhem 2023

Booking Information

Welcome to Magic and Mayhem, a fun-filled 24 hours for all Rainbows, Brownies and their leaders. The event will take place from 10am on Saturday 10 June to 10am on Sunday 11 June 2023 at Blackland Farm, Foxlease and Waddow Hall, with a one day option available on the Saturday (10am - 5.30pm).

A one day option is available at Glenbrook on Saturday 10 or Sunday 11 June 2023. Leaders do not require a licence to attend this event but it is a great opportunity to gain experience for or begin working towards the Going Away With Licence. For more information, speak to your local Commissioner about the Going Away With Scheme. Standard Girlguiding ratios must be maintained during Magic and Mayhem.

In this pack you will find all the initial information you require to make a booking for the event. Further information will be sent out once you have made a booking.

Magic and Mayhem costs £69 per person for girls and £40 per person for adults for the overnight, and £39 for the day event for girls and £15 for adults. The overnight ticket price includes accommodation (under canvas), Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast (Saturday lunch and snacks are not included), zone based activities in groups and transport to and from the local train station. Bookings are accepted upon receipt of a non-refundable holding deposit of £100 per group, and a completed booking form. In addition to that, £25 per person for overnight and £10 per person for a day visit is due four weeks after booking to confirm specific numbers. To confirm your booking, please ensure that the full balance of payment is made by 31 March 2023.

In late 2022 you will receive further information about the event, as well as a request for travel information, dietary requirements, additional information and event forms.

Please note: if necessary, leader's children are able to attend Magic and Mayhem, but they will not be able to participate in the main activities of the event. The cost for children is £25 per person for overnight and £10 per person for a day visit, and the full cost will need to be paid with the deposit payment.

Payment

- Deposits are strictly non-refundable and non-transferable.
- You may make your payment by cash, BACs, cheque or credit/debit card (unit cheques are preferred).
- Cheques must be made payable to 'The Guide Association'.
- Bookings will be accepted upon receipt of deposit.
- The full balance must be received by 31 March 2023 to confirm your booking.
- Failure to pay the full balance by 31 March 2023 will result in the cancellation of your booking and the loss of your deposit.

Alteration or cancellation of bookings

- Any increase or decrease in group numbers should be made by 31 March 2023. Please note that this will be subject to availability.
- Girlguiding will not be able to refund your deposit for a decrease in numbers.
- If you decide to cancel before 31 March 2023, Blackland Farm/Foxlease/Glenbrook/Waddow Hall will refund any balance paid. However, Blackland Farm/Foxlease/Glenbrook/Waddow Hall will not be able to refund your deposit.
- Cancellations or alterations to numbers made after 31 March 2023 are not eligible for any refund.
- If Blackland Farm/Foxlease/Glenbrook/Waddow Hall is unable to honour a booking due to staff shortages, structural problems or other unforeseen events that would force the centre to close, a full refund, including deposit, will be provided.
