

## A Safe Space Level 2: Safeguarding Responsibilities

Being alert, questioning behaviours, seeking advice and support and reporting any allegations, concerns or disclosures

Working with the HQ Safeguarding team where there are allegations, concerns or disclosures from their country or region

Supporting the country/region chief commissioner to provide guidance to local leadership teams

Supporting their region/area volunteers

Following the volunteer code of conduct

Having honest conversations with volunteers/parents/carers about any concerns

Knowing and following the processes for concerns, allegations and disclosures

Making reasonable adjustments for young people and other adults

Reading and implementing policies and procedures

Interpreting current legislation and making sure Girlguiding is legally compliant and demonstrating good safeguarding practice

Liaising with commissioners and Safeguarding HQ about open safeguarding cases when needed

Collecting and recording any medical/behaviour needs for young people

Instigating investigations about concerns, allegations and disclosures

Supporting other volunteers with any concerns, allegations or disclosures

Working in partnership with local Safeguarding teams, commissioners and units/leadership teams

Contacting social services if appropriate

Advising on and supporting units to complete risk assessments and support plans for adult volunteers when needed

Carrying out risk assessments/supporting plans of adult volunteers

Making sure their area is compliant and volunteers are up to date with processes and policies around how to report incidents, concerns, allegations and disclosures

Offering support and advice on managing safeguarding concerns, allegations and disclosures
