Brownie best bits

What you'll need:

- A3 paper
- Pens

Aim of activity

What's the best thing about being a Brownie? Share all your favourite moments and encourage others to join in the fun!

- 1 Get in a circle. Choose a Brownie to go first to say, 'My favourite thing about Brownies is...' They should include an action to represent their favourite thing.
- 2 The next Brownie in the circle should repeat what the previous Brownie said and did, then add their own new reason and action. Your leader will write down each favourite thing.
- 3 Keep going around the circle until everyone has had a go. Is it getting hard to remember everything? Your leader will display the list where everyone can see it.

4 Now imagine that your leader is a photographer – all do a pose to represent your favourite Brownie activities in a freeze frame. You could do your own pose or join up with others.

- 5 Get into Sixes with an A3 sheet of paper and pens. You're going to plan a way to encourage new Brownies to join your unit. You can make a poster, design and send out invitations, or even plan a special Brownie meeting for others to experience. Think about:
 - Who your audience is – school friends or new friends, for instance
 - Examples of things you do at Brownies that other people might enjoy
 - Something new you got to try because you became a Brownie

6 Get back together as a unit and share your ideas. Which do you like best?
